- Stephanie Collins, LPCC-S full time clinical counselor at Hudson High School, affiliated with Child Guidance & Family Solutions, and part time faculty member at Kent State University in the Clinical Mental Health Counseling Masters program. She has worked in outpatient and school settings for 26 years.
- Linda Cunningham, board certified psychiatric nurse practitioner with a wide variety
 of experience in the mental health field, including inpatient and outpatient psychiatry,
 psychiatric emergency medicine, and consultation and addiction medicine. She currently
 provides mental health treatment through Hygge psychiatry in Lakewood, Ohio.
